

Representing the British Pistol Club at International Competitions

The British Pistol Club is keen to encourage Members to participate in international competitions whilst representing the BPC. This policy documents outlines the terms under which Members can enter international competitions under the BPC's banner.

- 1 Potential entrants must notify the BPC Secretary by email (secretary@britishpistolclub.org) of their wish to enter the competition no later than 3 weeks before the deadline for entries to be submitted. Entrants will be notified of their acceptance within 7 days of this application.
- 2 Entrants will be liable for all of their own costs.
- 3 Once the entry is approved by the Secretary, entrants will be responsible for making their own arrangements for travel, accommodation and competition, unless notified by the Secretary that there will be a BPC Team Manager travelling.
- 4 In order to be considered to represent the BPC, the Member must have shot the following scores (or above) in 10m air pistol at a BPC competition in the previous 12 months. Scores from other competitions can be submitted to the Secretary for consideration.

10m Air Pistol	
Senior Men	550
Senior Women	540
Junior Men	510
Junior Women	500

- 5 Any Members under the age of 18 wishing to attend an overseas competition with the BPC must be accompanied by a Chaperone (aged 21 or over) who will take responsibility for the Junior during the competition.
- 6 Members are encouraged to wear BPC clothing whilst competing and on winning any podium places. Where ISSF clothing regulations are in effect then BPC clothing is required.
- 7 The BPC Committee reserves the right to refuse any Member's request.
