

11. Match 10. The Gallery Rifle Police Medals Match (Timed and Precision):

Practice 1. 25 yds: One series of twelve shots in 2 minutes to include a reload.

Practice 2. 15 yds: Two series of six shots. Targets will appear for 3 seconds with 5 second intervals: one shot to be fired at each exposure.

Practice 3. 10 yds: One series of six shots in 10 sec.

Targets: NRA DP 2 – HPS 300

12. Matches 12, 13 & 14. For Lightweight Sport Rifles, as defined by the NSRA and used in accordance with current NRA Range Safety Regulations. Match conditions will be as for Matches 8, 9 & 10, except that in Match 13 exposures will be 10 sec, 8 sec and 6 sec and in Match 14 targets will be NRA DP2 (Small).

#### Squadding

13. All matches will be squadded and, therefore, late entries can only be accepted subject to range space and firing point availability.

14. Squadding notices will be sent out to all competitors **provided that a Stamped, Self-Addressed envelope is forwarded with the entry form.** On request, full details of any course of fire will be sent out with Squadding notices.

#### Meals

15. All competitors are welcome to make use of the ATSC Clubhouse where meals and a bar service will be available throughout the Meeting.

#### Prizes and Prize Giving

16. There will be a Prize Giving on each day of the Meeting. These will take place in the ATSC Clubhouse at approximately 1730 hrs on Sat 10 May and at approximately 1800 hrs on Sun 11 May. All competitors are warmly invited to attend; a light tea will be provided.

#### Security

17. The Match Committee hopes that the high standards of firearm security set in previous years will be maintained. Please be alert for unauthorised persons who may wish to make capital from lapses: neither the ATSC nor its volunteer Range Staff can accept responsibility for the safeguarding of firearms, even during scoring sessions.

18. Competitors are respectfully reminded that all concerned are required to observe the provisions of the Firearms Acts.

### Match Conditions

5. Air pistols and all firearms must be recorded on the Competitor's Information Sheet, (which will be provided) and submitted to Equipment Control, before a competitor proceeds to the ranges.

6. The timings shown on Squadding Notices are the times at which shooting will commence. Competitors must allow themselves sufficient time to complete Equipment Control and for any setting up and preparation time allowed for any match. All events will be scored on range.

7. **Matches 16, 17, 18 & 20.** These matches will be fired in the spirit of ISSF conditions for the events named, except that they will be fired with suitable .22 or .177 calibre air pistols Final positions and any ties will be decided by counting back as laid down in Chapter 12 of the ISSF Pistol Rules.

8. **Match 2a, 2b and 2c.** For any muzzle loading pistol or revolver. One series of thirteen shots will be fired in 30 minutes; the best 10 to count. More than 50% of the shot hole must be over the line for the higher score to be given. The pistol or revolver must be held in one hand only. One warming, or fouling, shot may be fired into the Stop Butt within the overall time limit and with the prior permission of the Range Officer. Target PL7 – HPS 100.

9. **Matches 4, 5 & 6.** For muzzle loading revolvers in any caliber: except for Match 4, two hands may be used to hold the pistol.

Match 5. Silhouettes. There will be three exposures of the target in 40 sec, 30 sec and 20 sec; six rounds are to be fired at each exposure. Time will be allowed for reloading between each exposure. Target 1 x PL17 – HPS 180.

Match 6. Described in the NRA 'Bible' as The "Police Match" (Pistol). The match consists of two series of 12 shots and one series of six shots. Distances vary between 25m and 10m; timings are 12 minutes, 12 exposures of 2 sec and 3 exposures of 3 sec. Target 1 x NRA DP 2 (PAA) – HPS 300.

10. **Matches 8 9 & 10.** For Gallery Rifles as defined by the NRA and used in accordance with their current Range Safety Regulations:

Match 8. The America Match.

Practice 1. At 50m, two series of five shots in 5 minutes preceded by a sighting series of five shots in 5 minutes.

Practice 2. At 25m, two series of five shots in 30 sec.

Practice 3. At 25m, two series of five shots in 20 sec.

Targets: PL 17 at 50m, PL 7 at 25m – HPS 300.

Match 9. The Gallery Rifle Silhouettes Match 25m

Practice 1. Two series of five shots in 12 seconds, preceded by a sighting series of five shots in 12secs.

Practice 2. Two series of five shots in 10 sec.

Practice 3. Two series of five shots in 8 sec.

Targets: PL 7 – HPS 300.
