For events 1, 2, 3 & 4 the detail time shall be the start of the commands for the sighting series and shall be preceded by the appropriate preparation time: 5 minutes for Standard Pistol and Precision Stages, 3 minutes for Rapid Fire stages or events.

Athletes will be called to the line a few minutes before the preparation time and, when advised, will be allowed to set up their equipment.

For events 5, 6, 7 & 8, the detail times shown are the “START” time for the event (1st match shot).

The firing point will be open 30 minutes before to set up your equipment (15 minutes) and for your combined Preparation and Sighting time (15 minutes).

Medals

Medals will be awarded to the first three places in each squadded event (subject to number of entries).

Equipment Control

Voluntary Equipment Control for events 1-8 will be situated in the Lord Roberts Centre and will be available from 08:00 on Saturday and Sunday

Event Rules

Generally in accordance with the current ISSF Rules with the following major exceptions: -

- 1) Target centres may be used.
- 2) There will be no ISSF Finals or Shoot-offs. Count back as ISSF rule 6.15.1 will apply.
- 3) Competitors may complete a course of fire before other competitors begin.
- 4) Events 1 & 5 are confined to Men and Junior Men only.
- 5) Events 2 & 6 are confined to Women and Junior Women only.
- 6) Event 7 (if entered) must be shot before event 8.
- 7) The rules for events 3, 4, 7 & 8 shall be as the corresponding ISSF rules except that they shall be open to all.
- 8) Only those competitors able to comply with the ISSF shooting position, rule 8.7.1, will be eligible for finals and prize lists.
- 9) Other rules regarding events and prize eligibility to be as previously published by the BPC (available on request).
- 10) No professional photography will be allowed unless prior permission has been obtained from the BPC. The BPC's photography policy is available on our web site and can be read at the meeting reception.
