The British Pistol Club, founded in 1957, is the oldest and largest shooting club exclusive to pistol in Great Britain. It takes an active part in provision of shooting and encouragement of the sport. Since its inception, the Club has provided competitions and training in accordance with the International Shooting Sports Federation (ISSF). Using air pistols, we are currently shooting at 50m, at 25m Standard Handgun, Standard Pistol, Ladies Sport Pistol and Rapid Fire. At 10m to ISSF Rules, 60 shot Men's and 40 Shot Ladies' events,

Associate membership is open to anyone who can provide evidence of a serious interest in competitive shooting, and can achieve scores approaching those set as entry standards.

Full membership is normally only awarded to those who have represented Great Britain at Senior level in an International ISSF pistol match, or have achieved comparable status in any open squadded competition or have such other qualifications as to warrant election at the discretion of the Committee.

One of the many advantages of membership is the ability to enter any of the pistol events at the Club's monthly competitions and shoot alongside some of the country's top shooters. A friendly atmosphere makes it possible for new members to seek help and advice which improves their progress in the sport.

It is no exaggeration to say that any shooter with ambition, whether at County, Regional or National level, will benefit greatly if he or she becomes a member of The British Pistol Club.
